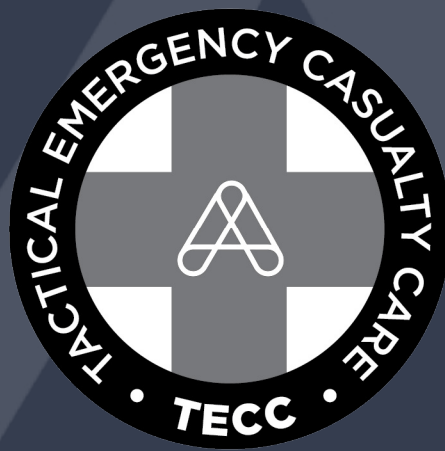

COURSE OVERVIEW

Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (TECC) is a scenario-based course that introduces candidates to Civilian Tactical Medicine.

Immersive in nature and fully embracing The ATACC Group ethos, this course aims to prepare candidates for deployment to high threat environments where further medical support is not readily available. Combined with the use of live actors and realistic casualty simulation, TECC provides a unique learning experience featuring 10 scenarios across the two days.

TECC is a dynamic, engaging and effective tactical medicine programme. It adopts an innovative but proven approach, which ensures retention of knowledge and skills, providing clear direction in how to ensure better patient outcomes.
